



Summer Lawn Watering Restrictions

Every year from May 1st to September 30th, the Clifton Park Water Authority limits lawn watering to odd/even days based on house number. If your home has an even-numbered address, you may water your lawn on even-numbered days of the month. Odd-numbered houses can water on odd-numbered days. These measures are put in place to conserve water and reduce the demand on our water system so we can ensure that sufficient capacity and pressure exists for all necessary water needs including domestic water use and fire protection.

Customers found violating these restrictions will be given a warning and will be fined \$100 per incident for any subsequent violations.

Please be aware of the inclining block rate structure used for billing by the Authority. Chart your water usage to avoid any surprises when the bill arrives.
